

Installation & Operating Instructions

LED Bathroom Mirror

Safety Warnings



Installation should only be performed by qualified installers and technicians.

Regulations require that electrical work be carried out only by a licensed electrician.

- Carefully check the appliance for damage after unpacking it. Do not connect or install the appliance if it has been damaged in transit as this will void the warranty.
- This product is fragile, and should be handled with care during installation. Remove the protective film only once the mirror is completely installed.
- When using any electrical appliance, basic electrical safety precautions should always be
 observed.
- Do not use this appliance for any purpose other than its intended use. It is suitable for standard household use only. Not suitable for commercial or industrial purposes.
- Do not install outdoors.
- This product must be connected to a grounded electrical circuit, following regulations specified in the relevant electrical codes.
- Completely disconnect the power before beginning installation.
- Do not seal the installed mirror with silicone or tiles, as this will interfere with future maintenance.
- Do not modify or attempt to modify any of the characteristics of this appliance, or attempt to repair it yourself. Doing so could pose a safety hazard.
- Cleaning should not be undertaken by persons including children with reduced physical, sensory
 or mental capabilities, or those who lack experience and knowledge.
- Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers to clean the appliance including the mirror glass as they can damage the surface and may result in shattering of the glass.
- Do not apply too much pressure when cleaning the mirror.
- Do not use a steam cleaner.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Take care when cleaning the mirror.


Clean the glass with a mild glass cleaner applied to a soft cloth or paper towel, and not applied directly to the mirror. Wipe in a circular motion to avoid streaks. Clean other surfaces with a damp soft cloth. After cleaning, dry the surfaces with a dry microfiber cloth or towel to remove any moisture and prevent streak marks.

Avoid the use of abrasive cleaners on the mirror and frame surfaces as this can damage the glass, cause scratches, and dull the surface. Avoid using cleaning products that contain ammonia or alcohol-based cleaners as they can damage the anti-fog and LED coating.

Do not use any glass scrapers or steam cleaners to clean this product.


Installation Instructions

Measure the distance between the two hooks on the backside of the mirror.




Determine the installation height and mark the wall. Ensure that there is adequate clearance above the basin tap and the bottom of mirror when it is in its final position once installed.

Pre-drill holes and install appropriate fixings into the supporting wall.

Hang the mirror on the fixings, then double-check that the mirror is correctly installed and sufficiently supported. Use packers to stabilise if required.

Operating Instructions



To turn on the mirror light, touch the power operation button. To turn off, touch the power button again. To adjust the brightness of the light, press and hold the button.



To turn on the mirror defogger, touch the demister button. To turn off, touch the demister button again. For best results use the demister function to prevent condensation.

The mirror may go into sleep mode if it has not been used for a period of time. In this event simply touch the control button to engage operation.
